## WHAT YOUR HOUSE NUMBER MEANS TO YOU

---

There are some properties you enter and never want to leave; others, you can't wait to get out of. There could be a good reason for this and that reason could be as simple as the number that represents the house.

It's simple enough to leave if you can, but what if you live in a property where you have never felt comfortable? Move? Seems a little extreme but sometimes, no matter how nice the house is; you never have and never will feel comfortable there.

Check out these numbers below to see where your house fits and a 'quick fix' solution that could help your unhappy abode.

It's handy to keep this in mind when house hunting in order to get the property that works best for you.

### TO DO A NUMEROLOGICAL CALCULATION OF YOUR ADDRESS:

1: Use the chart below to calculate the number using the house number added to the calculation for the street name. Don't include the word Street, Road, Avenue, Cell Block... just the name of the street. So if you live in Harley Street, you only calculate the number of the house and 'Harley'.

2: **The numbers** must come down to a single digit, so keep calculating. For instance, if your house number is 666 (*you little devil you*), add  $6+6+6 = 18$ , then take the 18 break it down and add those numbers together  $1 + 8 = 9$ , which is the calculation for the house number.

3: The house number is then added to the address; that is, the name of the street, NOT including the word 'Street', remember!

What If **the address** is *East* Granby St? In the case of North (3) South (2) East (9) or West (4), you would include this as part of the address name.

If the address includes an abbreviated East, for instance, E.45<sup>th</sup> Ave, then only use the letter 'E', (which would be 5, as opposed to 9 if you used the word 'East').

***NB: In the case of 45<sup>TH</sup> Ave you would only count 4+5; don't include the 'th' or any other abbreviations for numbers (as in 6th, 1st, 2nd).***

## NUMEROLOGICAL CONVERSION TABLE

---

**A=1, B=2, C=3, D=4, E=5, F=6, G=7, H=8, I=9**

**J=1, K=2, L=3, M=4, N=5, O=6, P=7, Q=8, R=9**

**S=1, T=2, U=3, V=4, W=5, X=6, Y=7, Z=8**

4: Add the number of the property to the name of the street and hey presto! You have the number that represents your house:

**666 East Granby St;** the calculation would go as follows:

House number 666:  $(6+6+6 = 18 \ 1+8) = 9 +$

East:  $(E=5 \ A=1 \ S=1 \ T=2) = 9 +$

Street name:  $(G=7 + R=9 + A=1 + N=5 + B=2 + Y=7) = 31$

**Total = 49**

(break this number down)  $4+9 = 13$

(break this number down to a single digit)  $1+3 = 4$

The number for this address then is represented by **4.**

## YOUR PROPERTY NUMBER:

Numerology is represented by the numbers 1 through to 9, there is no 0

# NUMBER 1:

**Planet: The Sun**

**Most suited to: High Flyers**



A number 1 house quite often belongs to a person with a high position in work, and to one who has a definite ambition. It can also be the home of someone destined to be famous, or even *infamous!* More likely to attract/suit singles rather than couples.

The No 1 is a 'Male' house, as in, it reflects masculine attributes of assertiveness and exploration. This is the house of someone who loves to try out new and exciting things; a person who is impulsive, and adventurous.

**Careers:** I.T. marketing, publishing

**It's also good for those looking to make a fresh start in life.** If you've been lacking in energy, have lost your direction in life and are determined to regain some of that youthful vigour, then a No 1 is ideal.

## **Least Suited To:**

Families and couples: those wishing to start a family and settle down. Those looking for a Long term, low maintenance property. No 1 houses often need a lot of upkeep. The fast pace of those it attracts is reflected in how the property ages – which is usually pretty quickly.

## **DECOR**

---

It's all a matter of taste and those best suited to No 1s are probably the greatest example of '*money doesn't equal taste!*' This house will attract attention, be it good or bad. Onlookers will either love or hate it. (Think Adina in *Absolutely Fabulous*, meets Liberace and you get the idea).

The interior should be kept clutter free and minimalist. Colour schemes of white, orange and gold and other strong bright colours work well. Windows should be large and free of ornaments on the ledges or hanging crystals from the windows.

## NUMBER 2:

**Planet: The Moon**

**Most Suited To:**

**Home Based Self Employed and Nature Boy (or girl)**



Unlike No 1, those best suited to a No 2 house are laid back and happy to take life at their own pace. The garden would be a feature in this property and would be laid out to attract wildlife, with little nooks and crannies, rather than a highly manicured space.

This property draws others to it by its 'vibe, man!' Children especially are responsive to its warm and friendly atmosphere. The house is regularly filled with children although those who live in it are less likely to have any of their own. You can almost smell the freshly baked cookies wafting from the windows – which is the problem with this property as its one where being laid back can turn into comatose, inviting laziness and consequently weight gain. The only time this changes is when values are challenged, which is when a surprisingly unbending attitude rears its loud and angry head.

Unmarried couples and singles do well here. Sex is not a taboo subject and although often 'casual' the act itself is seen as a natural and sensual act, rather than a notch on the bedpost or only to be performed on the third Tuesday of the month with the lights off and the curtains drawn.

**Careers:** The No 2 house can be an ideal place from which to run a home-based business. A great base for a foster home and for those recuperating from eating disorders who need to build up their self-esteem and gain weight.

**Least Suited To:**

RIGID PEOPLE WHO LIVE BY A TIMETABLE WILL NOT FIND THE EASY-GOING ATMOSPHERE COMFORTABLE OR TRADITIONAL FAMILY UNITS WHO WISH TO HAVE A STABLE, UNCHANGING HOUSEHOLD.

People who like to 'keep themselves to themselves' and prefer friends and neighbours to call three weeks in advance of a visit would not do well here. This is a 'take us as you find us' and drop in anytime kind of place.

'BLINGY' HIGH FLYERS – ALTHOUGH, YOU ARE JUST AS LIKELY TO FIND THE HIGH END GADGETS IN A NO 2 HOUSE, THEY ARE LESS 'IN YER FACE'. THE LATEST SOUND SYSTEM WOULD BE ACQUIRED FOR HOW MUCH IT EXPANDS THE LISTENER'S ENJOYMENT OF MUSIC, RATHER THAN BEING 'THE THING TO BE SEEN TO HAVE'.

**Décor:**

Sensuous fabrics in pastel shades do well here, particularly pinks and creams. Plants thrive next to art that runs from the traditional to the abstract – just so long as it flows and doesn't jar. Fluffy throws over the sides of big comfy chairs and couches that naturally invite you to slip off your shoes and curl your legs up.

A number 2 house is usually a good buy, appreciates well and is fairly easy to maintain.

## **NUMBER 3:**

**Planet: Jupiter**

**Most Suited To: The Self Employed Communicator**



Movers and shakers, move into a No.3. This is a house of communication in any and every form, phones, faxes, computers, ipad, ipods, iphones. No 3 could have a WWW in front of it as the occupants will be spending a lot of time on the net and may even have their own website.

The No 3 is a great transitory address for people on their way up in the world. Lucky breaks can occur in abundance, which contributes to the transitory nature as those that live here move up in the world.

This house will be a hub of activity; If you like having a phone to either ear while emailing to worldwide contacts, then this is the place for you.

### **Careers:**

Like No 2, this is a good spot for the self-employed, but unlike No 2, the No 3 offers a temporary respite and a convenient place for the office which may not be returned to for days, even weeks at a time. This person is on the go and could travel the country if not the world. Graphic/commercial artists (as opposed to 'arty' artists), journalists, executives, writers, those involved in telecommunications do well as will those whose jobs give them a gypsy-like lifestyle.

### **Least Suited To:**

Those looking for a cozy home atmosphere and a place to settle would not do well here. This is a 'stopping off place', a place to stay when you're in town, but not a nest. Not a place for families or with a regular 9-5 lifestyle as they're likely to feel as though the ground won't remain still under their feet.

### **Décor:**

Light, bright, FUNctional – no, that's not a typo – the furnishings need to be Fun, easily maintained, brightly coloured with the occasional unique piece here and there. It should reflect the itinerate artist that dwells within. Sunshine yellows and dramatic purples work well along-side wicker furniture. Think Ikea.

## NUMBER 4:

**Planet: Sun**

**Most Suited To: The Family Home**



*'Hello honey, I'm home!'* The Number 4 house truly is a home. This is the place with the slippers warming on the hearth, the kids playing under the Christmas tree and Mom (or dad) baking cookies in the kitchen.

The home as the safe haven is ideally represented by the number 4. This is the place you will want to live for ever. But be warned, you either won't be able to get rid of the kids, or they will be paying many visits back home, bringing the grandkids and great grand kids with them; it's just as well really, as you will be reluctant to downsize and move to a smaller property when the chicks have flown the nest.

This property will appreciate nicely in value and will only grow in character as it ages. They are usually snapped up quickly based on the 'feel' people get from it. Like No 1 it is ruled by the Sun, but think of this property as representing the warmth and nurture the sun gives to make things grow, as opposed to the dynamic energy associated with the No 1 property.

**Careers:** Any career that means you won't have to be away from home for too long. From the traditional office job, to a nursery to running a farm; this property lends itself to any number of lifestyles, just so long as they center around or can come back to home base. Think *It's a Wonderful Life*.

**Least Suited To:** Anyone who doesn't suit it!

Ah, now, here lies the rub; for this 'ideal' property is a fixed character, and if you don't fit with it, it will spit you out. For those who are up for the pipe and slippers, it is ideal. Offspring however, may rebel and find it suffocating (although will probably look back in later years with fond memories).

The property itself may have an unusual characteristic that you have to embrace, because it WILL NOT be changed! If you try, the who house will seem off kilter.

For single, modern thinking, upwardly mobile people the Number 4 would be simply too old fashioned, oppressive and odd looking.

The house could cost a fortune in heating bills as you can never get rid of the draft, or have doors that won't close properly no matter how much you shave off here and



there. The number 4 is a classic, you either love it or hate it – it divides - and you may find family members pulling in very different directions under its influence.

### **Décor:**

To make the most out of this property you need to maximise the harmonious elements. Develop a garden for family barbecues and allow the kids to make their rooms their own, not putting restrictions on what they can put on the walls etc. For them to embrace the 4 house and not to feel suffocated by it, they need some freedom of expression.

Go for earthy muted tones with a splash of bright red or green on the door and possibly the windows to give the place a splash of verve.

# NUMBER 5

**Planet: Mercury**

**Most Suited To: Freedom loving singles and Interior Designers**



This house is full of creativity and artistic ideas. Luxury abounds with latest gadgetry, but as with the No. 2 house, they are to get the best out of audio and visual media, rather than for the kudos of having the latest gear. This home is full of colour and beauty.

There will almost certainly be some mode of transport, such as a car or even a motorbike; this house does tend to bring out the Wild Child. The occupant will often be out experiencing new things and planning to return.... whenever.

Here the singleton can go wild and use their home for releasing their artistic self-expression. They also may be releasing other forms of self-expression as they release their passions and embark on a journey of self-discovery, no matter their age.

It is quite likely that along that voyage, this single occupancy dwelling will find a stowaway and romances will blossom into true love; at which point the No 5 house will be vacated for the two lovers to begin their new life in a long term No 6 home, leaving the house free for the next singleton to move in to.

## **Careers:**

Freewheeling abounds within these walls which best suits the self-employed arty artists. Not the type of self-employment that demands diligence and organisation – there will be too many people coming and going. The only thing on a (loose) timetable you may find is a drop-in writing group or art class – from noon(ish) to four(ish), come and go as you please, no excuses necessary.

## **Least Suited To:**

Families, regular folks, (as in 9=5ers) those needing stability or wishing to put down roots; which is why this house tends to have a high turnover of occupants, as there

are few who wish to continue in a life style that is often a 'phase' on the way to where the occupant is meant to be.

**Décor:**

The design of this house will reflect the arty occupant: bright colours, quirky buys found at car boot sales and creative, imaginative uses of niches. There may be something 'quirky' about the house itself which will draw the right person to it. It is a lucky house and will often turn a good profit for those who buy it 'on a hunch'. Don't be surprised if each time you enter this house the colour scheme has changed entirely, or the furniture has been moved around AGAIN! This house is ruled by Mercury which is the house of communication and movement – you will certainly know it in this house.

## NUMBER 6:

**Planet: Venus**

**Most Suited To: Art/Music Teachers**



When thinking of the No 6 house, you can almost hear the theme tune to *The Waltons* in the background. This is the ideal home to bring up baby and cats, and dogs and hamsters and.... Even better than the 4, which can be suffocating to some in the family, the No 6 is the all-round nurturer.

This is a busy household, full of fun and laughter and something going on in every room and kids growing up feeling loved, nurtured and allowed to find their feet in a safe loving environment.

For newly-weds this is the ideal place in which to become a couple and start your family.

### **Careers:**

The number 6 can be a great place to start home run businesses such as landscape gardening, local handy-man, man-and-a-van style of service. It's also an ideal residence for those who work with young people, including teachers, especially those who teach the creative arts such as painting, drama and music. Kids would have no complaints about taking their piano classes from this abode. Number 6 is an ideal place to run Human Rights, Hug-a-Tree kind of campaigns.

### **Least Suited To:**

The No 6 would be wasted on those who cannot spend enough time in it to enjoy it fully. Strangely there is something about this house that brings your just deserts, or Karma; which of course is great for those who've done good things, not so great for those who bury bodies under the patio. Here your chickens come home to roost, but even if there is some negative Karma coming your way, this house is a safe place in which to go through difficult times.

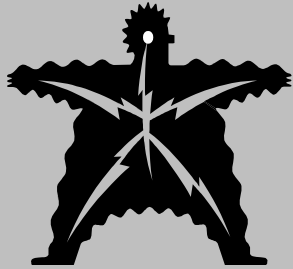
### **Décor:**

Beautiful pastel shades, lots of *objet d'art*, soft sensual fabrics, water features and Feng Shui abound. Very tastefully decorated but with enough occasional quirks to stop it lacking character.

# NUMBER 7

**Planet: Moon**

**Most Suited To: Dr Who**



Probably more than any other number, the No 7 house reflects and magnifies the attributes of the occupant.

If you are into some dodgy dealing, then expect law suits and a run in with the law or tax man.

If you give out a calm energy and have psychic abilities, this house will enhance them.

If your marriage is going through a rough patch, then the likelihood is you won't be here long before the divorce papers are coming through the door.

It can be a great place to live, full of fun and excitement and adventure, if that's what you want.

The tarot card The Moon best sums up the dichotomy of this house: the card can represent a growing spiritual and mystical awareness and a development of those aspects. The moon can also represent someone who has their head buried in the sand and is living in a fantasy land and refusing to see the truth of the matter. Whichever of these aspects represents you, the No 7 house may be a necessary stage for you to go through.

One of the keys to knowing whether your No 7 house is going to be more on the side of positive energies can be found in whether or not the 7 is made up from 16. A 16/7 (that is  $1+6=7$ ) is more likely to bring negative energies than dynamic positive energies.

## **Careers:**

Ironically, if it is not from a 16/7 combination it can be a great place of calm, introspection and healing. It can be an ideal address for those seeking solitude, on deep spiritual journey, or for writers who need to isolate themselves from the outside world to write the life changing masterpiece. No 7 is a house that reflects the needs and requirements of the occupants, whether that be a stern life lesson, or a safe harbour. Philosophers and mad scientists would also do well here.

## **Least Suited To:**

The No 7 is not right for those looking to settle down to a quiet life. Those who like a quiet life with few peaks and troughs would not feel comfortable here. However, if

you need to rid yourself of a long standing situation that you have let drag on because you can't face the trauma of it, then the No 7 could be exactly what you need; it may be a wrench, but it will get rid of negative energies/relationships and help you move on: in which case, when you reach the end of your catharsis, the next property with the right number will appear as if by magic!

### **Décor:**

This house can be a little odd looking; it may appear to be one thing from the outside and something entirely different from within; a bit like a Tardis (hence Dr Who). Make sure you have a good damp course as this can often be an issue in a 7 address.

Colours should go along spiritual orange, yellow and purples. To keep the energies right it's important to have a quiet room, one that you use for meditation, or reading quietly.

# NUMBER 8:

**Planet: Saturn**

**Most Suited To: Big Goals**



This is the house of extremes. Rules by Saturn, if you plan big, think big and ACT upon those plans, you could acquire wealth beyond your wildest dreams.

If you dream big and have over-inflated ideas about your abilities or are too lazy or not motivated enough to follow those dreams through to reality, then you could lose big in the 8 house.

No 8 is the house of hedonism and excess. Think someone who made their fortune in the IT boom, drives a Porche and considers a relationship of anything over three weeks to be too much commitment.

However, for those in a committed relationship where both have a vision and a dynamic attitude to attain their goal, this house could bring about the oomph to help them along the way.

## **Careers:**

Finance led careers, such as Stock Market traders and those whose ideal is to 'get in. make your money – get out fast' suit a No 8 residence. This is the house for those who put career before home and family. Suited to the highly motivated and highly ambitious will do well, but beware as these goals and lifestyle can leave the occupant morally bankrupt and – if too much of a gamble is made, possibly financially bankrupt also.

## **Least Suited To:**

Couples who do not have a solid commitment to each other. Relationships that are not based on total trust, honesty and a 'no mind-games' rule will be in trouble very quickly as temptations brought from a hedonistic lifestyle are hard to resist in a No 8 house.


Those who have problems with excesses and addictions may find they lose control completely and their life becomes a runaway train that could spell disaster.

Not a family home.

**Décor:**

New! New! New! The latest, most expensive gadgets are required. The No 8 is certainly no place for antiques or 'quaint' items found in a car boot sale!

Colours should be bold and dynamic with splashes of red strategically placed. The bedroom needs to be as calm as possible with TV and computers strictly prohibited as the No 8 has such energy that it can be difficult to turn off and relax enough to sleep.





## NUMBER 9:

**Planet: Mars**

**Most Suited To: Students of Life and Caregivers.**



THERE IS A SENSE OF MATURITY AND BELONGING IN THE NO 9 HOUSE. WISDOM AND A DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF THE FOIBLES OF THE HUMAN CONDITION ARE TO BE FOUND WITHIN THESE WARM AND WELCOMING WALLS.

Suited both to the student and the retiree this house brings calm and serenity and is a safe harbour for friends and family. The sense of well-being allows for a greater comprehension when studying and looking for deeper meaning in life. That comprehension spreads way beyond the boundaries of its walls into the world beyond. The No 9 occupants will take an interest in worldly matters and may even do a fair amount of travelling and may have a variety of overseas contacts and friends.

Pets seem to do well in a No 9 house and you may find the odd stray cat who decides to adopt you, as felines in particular are drawn to the nurturing nature of this house.

This is a house that suits, young and old, single and married – in fact married couples' relationships may take on a much deeper bond in this abode.

### **Careers:**

Although, as it is ruled by Mars, this is a great house for those who are goal oriented; unlike the No 8, where the primary goal is to make money, the goal for the No 9 occupants is the love of what they are doing, with financial reward being secondary. This is the home of the writer who wishes to bring enlightenment to the world and be revered by their peers, rather than someone who wishes to make a fortune from their work. Human Rights lawyers, writers, philosophers, scholars, gardeners, pet sanctuaries, homes for the terminally bewildered, would all do well at this address.

### **Least Suited To:**

At some stage in every person's life there will be a period that the No 9 suits their needs; quite often when coming to the end of a period and needing to gather resources in order to move on. For some it is the last house they will live in as they find all they need here. For others it is a stopping off point to get them ready to start off on their next quest.

## Décor:

Pastels, plants and flowing fabrics, contrasted with shelves and wall space for degrees and awards relating to career success of the occupant and to encourage even more success! Fresh cut flowers sit nicely next to medals. The smell of coffee to keep the occupant alert for their tasks contrasts nicely with the smell of fresh baked cookies for the reward when they're done. This is a house of contrasts that sit well together and rarely conflict.

# YOUR NUMBER AND YOUR HOUSE

---

I am often asked: *what is the best house to suit my personal number?* This is not as simple as it sounds when you consider that you may be in a couple or a whole family of people, each with different numbers.

However, as a basic rule, take your number and add 4 to get the house that should best suit your needs.

In order to get your number use your date of birth and add up the numbers:

For example 15 June 1979

(15)  $1+5 = 6$

(June) + 6 (only ever use the number of the month not the letters J.U.N.E)

(1979)  $+1+9+7+9 = (26) 26$

$6+6+26 = 38$  break the 38 down  $3+8 = 11$  break the 11\* down  $1+1 = 2$

## Your Number is 2

So for a number two person, the ideal house would be No 6

*\*There is an interesting feature about 2 when it breaks down from the number 11 which also affected the number 7 (please read the No 7 for when the number is found via 1+6) I will go into these 'magic' numbers in a later article.*

The rule of thumb then is to add 4 to your own number; but you should also consider what stage you are at in your life. It could be the ideal house for you is a 5, but for RIGHT NOW you need to be in a 1.
